To apply for exemption, complete AP-204 and include any written material that describes the chamber's activities, or a Web site that provides this information. If the organization is unincorporated, include a copy of the organization's governing document, such as the bylaws or constitution. The document must show that the organization is nonprofit.

Guidelines to Texas Tax Exemptions

The late fees cannot be waived and are calculated at \$25 per month or partial month starting the 31st day after the 1st Delinquency letter was mailed. An organization must satisfy all the requirements of the ITS to stop the late fees from accruing. *NOTE: Use of charitable assets is restricted to charitable purposes.

Estimated Tax Penalty - Individuals | otr

Taxpayers are required to complete and send the tax return back to the Inland Revenue Department (IRD) within 1 month from the date of issue of the return (i.e. on or before 3 June 2021). For sole-proprietors of unincorporated businesses, the deadline for submission is extended to 3 August 2021.

Existing law requires persons convicted of specified sex offenses and certain acts of human trafficking for purposes of committing various sex offenses or extortion, as specified, or attempts to commit those offenses, to register with local law enforcement agencies while residing in the state or while attending school or working in the state.
